

Step 8 Click the **Browse** button, located in the centre of the screen

Step 9 You will now need to locate the file you downloaded earlier in **Step 2**. Browse to the file and click **Open**



Step 10 Click **Save Settings** and click **OK** to the warning prompts. The VoIP unit will now update the firmware and reboot.

IMPORTANT: During the upgrade process **DO NOT** turn off or unplug any cables from the unit.

The upgrade process may take up to 1-2 minutes.

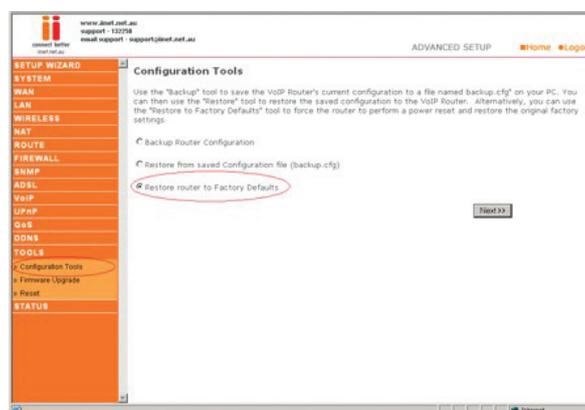
You will now need to restore the unit to factory defaults

Step 1 Type in your current password (default password = admin) then click **LOGIN**

Step 2 On the left hand side of the screen click **Advanced Setup**

Step 3 You will now be presented with more options in the menu on the left. Click **Tools** and then **Configuration Tools**.

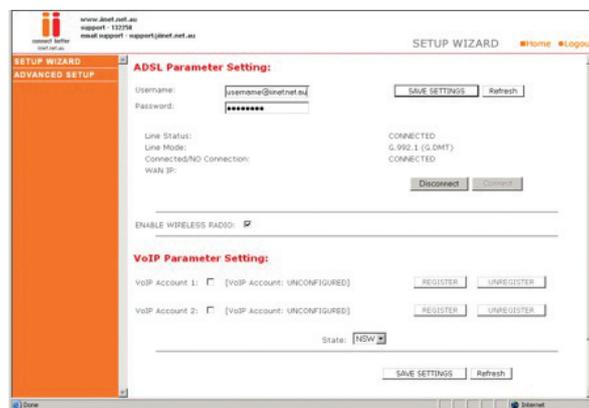
Step 4 Place a **'Dot'** next to **Restore Router to Factory Defaults** and click **Next**



Step 5 Click on the **Apply** button and then click **OK** to the warning screen

Congratulations, you have successfully upgraded to the latest firmware. You will now need to re-enter your username and password for your internet connection:

- Step 1** In the Address Bar, delete any text and type in 10.1.1.1 or [Click Here](#) to open the page directly
- Step 2** Type in your current password (default password = admin) then click **LOGIN**
- Step 3** Enter your username and password for your internet connection (eg. username@iinet.net.au, username@ozemail.com.au) then click **Save Settings**



- Step 4** Once the settings have been saved, enter in your VoIP phone number, password and appropriate State then click on **Save Settings**
